

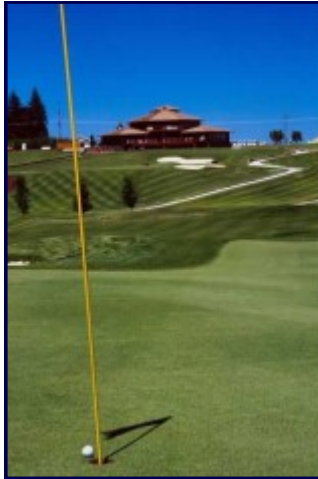
Golf Tournament

From TROY: Take I-75 N to exit 227 (M-55 to Prudenville). Follow M-55 W into Prudenville (9 miles), and turn left on S Reserve Rd (McDonald's is on the corner). Camp CoBeAc is 2½ miles on the left.

From GOLF: Head north on N Clare Ave (11½ miles). Turn right onto Co Rd 400/Emery Rd (4 miles). Turn right onto Co Rd 401/S Reserve Rd. Camp CoBeAc is ½ mile on the left.



Take I-75 N to exit 162B (US 10). Go west on US 10. US-10 merges with US-127. Continue north on US-127 to exit 176. Turn right onto N Clare Ave (at end of ramp), go 3 miles, and The Tamaracks will be on your right.
